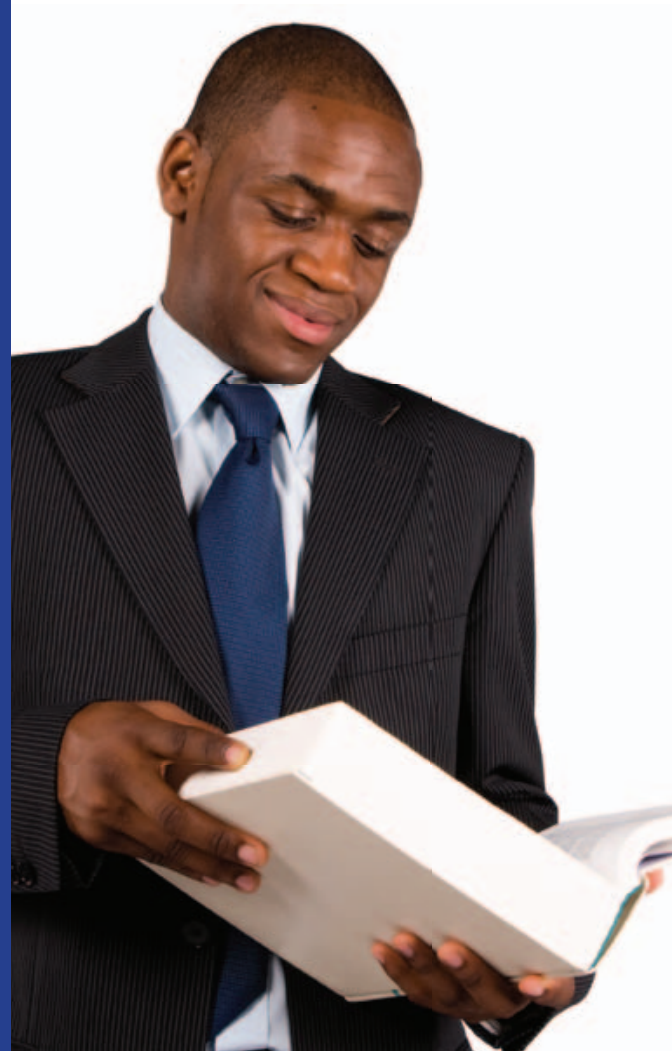
## Mission of College and Career Academies

## College and Career Academies at Manley

### Culinary Arts and Hospitality

The Culinary Arts and Hospitality Academy teaches students professional cooking and baking techniques, leadership skills and business knowledge necessary to be successful in college and careers. By the last year on instruction, students will have gained the skills necessary to enroll in college and gain entry-level back of the house (BOH) or front of the house (FOH) employment.



### Medical Assistant

In the Medical Assistant Academy, students establish a foundation of administrative and clinical skills related to the principles of medical assisting. Knowledge and skills are obtained through experiences with common clerical duties, handling patient/client data files, preparing patients for procedures, performing basic laboratory tests, and carrying out clinical duties such as taking vital signs, sterilizing instruments, preparing patients for procedures, and performing basic laboratory tests.
